<u>Catechesis</u> is "...a name given to the totality of the Church's effort to make disciples." A disciple is someone who faithfully follows and imitates Jesus Christ. The primary purpose of <u>Catechesis</u> is then to put parishioners in communion with Jesus Christ.² To know Jesus intimately is <u>Eternal Life</u>³. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life," so let us follow Him all the way to Heaven! Parents are both privileged and obligated to hand-on the Faith to their children by making their homes a <u>domestic church</u>. The Christian home is "a school of human virtues and of Christian Charity." Since the "Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life," so please come to Mass every Sunday and lead your child/ren to Jesus, the Word of Life.

Word of Life is one of the best catechetical resources available to parents/educators both to learn and teach our Catholic Faith. "Faith is the greatest gift parents can give their children. Dear Parent, God has entrusted you with the responsibility of teaching your child/ren the truth about God, the Church, and what it means to be a human person. You are the primary educator of your child/ren, and this task can be very challenging [for busy families]. Therefore, the mission of the Word of Life [curriculum] is to equip you to lead your child/ren to Jesus, the Word of Life."

Holy Cross & Our Mother of Sorrows parishioners rely on the Family Faith Formation (FFF) Model. FFF puts the family at the center of the catechetical instruction process, increasing parents' competence and confidence in handing-on the Faith to their children. They meet in-person monthly at Our Mother of Sorrows (OMOS) church to find support and strength from clergy, fellow parishioners, parish staff, and catechists. Parents should strive to make their homes a domestic church by setting aside time for individual and communal prayer, reading scripture prayerfully, *lectio divina*, and through family devotions such as praying the rosary among others. FFF is essentially a Study-at-Home program with an opportunity to gather with fellow parishioners at least monthly. FFF starts with Mass attendance at OMOS at 11:00 a.m. Snacks are served downstairs immediately following Mass. Dedicated catechists work alongside parents and offer interactive and age-appropriate catechetical instruction from 12:15 to 1:30 p.m. IF families cannot make the Sunday monthly FFF sessions, they can attend the Wednesday monthly sessions at Holy Cross Parish Center from 6:30 to 7:45 p.m. Monthly FFF schedule is available on the next page.
