Music appropriate for Church:

Secular instrumental music (public domain) can be performed when the guests are arriving before the ceremony (prelude music). Only sacred compositions are suitable for the ceremony and Mass.

Additional compositions:

If there is a musical piece you would like to be included in your celebration and it is a piece outside of my repertoire list, please make sure to provide the piano or organ score at least a month before the wedding. If it is a sacred vocal solo, the score must contain both the piano and vocal parts. The score should be printed in high quality and written or transcribed for piano or organ (and not any other instrument). Lead sheets or melody lines will not be accepted. The selected composition must be either a part of the public domain or found in our hymnals (licensed for public performing, streaming and recording).

Large quantities of additional music (beyond 4 pages), as well as extra rehearsals (beyond the cantor/organist rehearsal) are subject to a practice fee (\$60 per hour).

Following the suggestion of the Diocesan guidelines these musical pieces are not permitted at Holy Cross / Our Mother of Sorrows Church:
